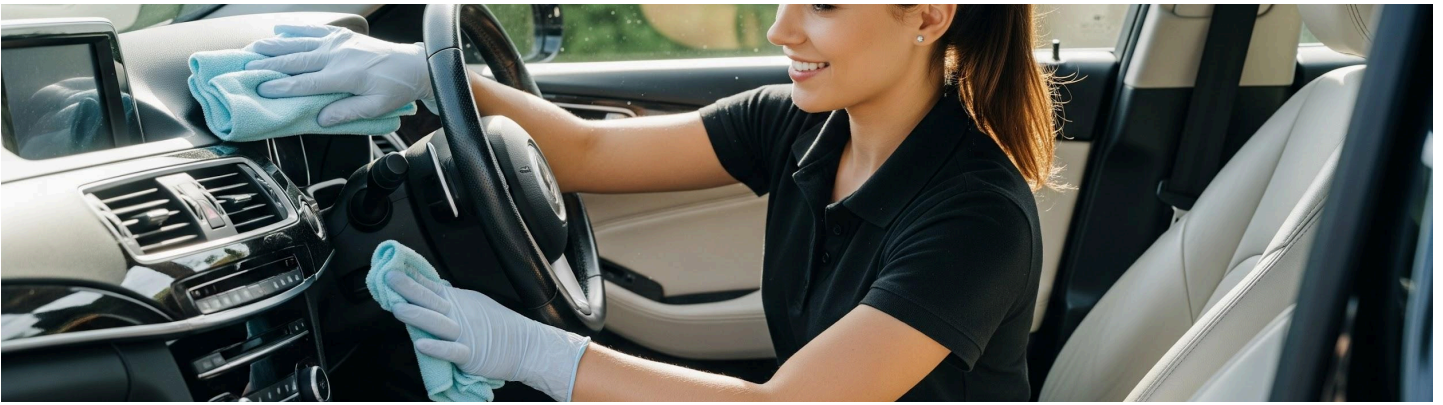




Superstratum Car Detox Instructions

Transform your vehicle into a healthier space with the Superstratum Car Detox system. Follow these steps carefully for optimal results.

Step 1: Prep the Space

Why: A successful detox starts with removing contaminants like dust, dirt, and debris that harbor mold, mycotoxins, and bacteria.

- **Vacuum Thoroughly:** Use a HEPA vacuum if possible. These capture small particles that typical vacuums may recirculate.
- **Clean Out:** Remove all trash, floor mats, and clutter from the vehicle. Shake out or wash the floor mats separately.

Step 2: Spot Treat with PurOne

Why: If you see visible mold or microbial staining, it's critical to treat it first.

- Use PurOne Tablets according to the product's included instructions.

Step 3: Surface Cleaning with Everyday Cleaner

Why: Dust is where mycotoxins hide. You need to remove it completely from every surface.

- Spray Superstratum Everyday Cleaner on all hard and soft surfaces: dashboard, doors, steering wheel, center console, seats, etc.
- Let it sit for 10–15 seconds.
- Wipe with a paper towel and dispose immediately to remove contaminants, not redistribute them.

Step 4: Prep for Deodor Bomb

Why: CLO₂ gas is powerful but needs to be applied safely to avoid damage to your vehicle's interior.

- Place the Deodor Bomb on a flat surface inside the car.
- **Important:** Lay newspaper or cardboard under the container to protect surfaces from potential bleaching from residual liquid or high-concentration gas.

Optional Enhancement:

- Place a battery-powered fan inside the vehicle for better gas circulation. Do not place the fan directly over the Deodor Bomb.
- If your vehicle has a remote start, turn on the fan (no AC or heat) remotely during the deodorizing process to push gas through the ventilation system. Turn off after 2 hours.

Step 5: Activate Deodor Bomb

Why: This is the core detox step that neutralizes airborne mycotoxins, VOCs, and lingering microbial activity.

- Follow the product's instructions to activate.
- Do this step overnight with the car sealed and parked in a safe, ventilated area.

Step 6: Air Out the Vehicle

Why: While CLO₂ breaks down into harmless salts, some sensitive individuals may react to residual gas.

- In the morning, open all doors and air out the car for 1–2 hours.
- If you're highly sensitive: Air out for 1–2 days.
- **Warning Signs:** If you feel lightheaded, nauseous, or short of breath upon reentry, exit immediately and continue airing out the vehicle.

Step 7: Apply Endurance Coating

Why: This is how you keep your car clean. Spray the invisible coating—know that it won't grow mold.

- Spray Superstratum Endurance Coating on:
 - Carpeted areas
 - Floor mats
 - Cloth or fabric seats
- Allow to dry fully.
- Reapply every 3–6 months depending on vehicle use, exposure to water, or spill-prone areas.

Final Tips:

- Do this full detox on a warm dry day.
- Never use CLO₂ near people, pets, or open flames.
- Keep children and sensitive individuals away from the vehicle until fully aired out.
